Dear Exhibitors

Thank you so much to everyone who participated in our 2019 show series. We hope everyone enjoyed the shows!

Our shows have an early entry fee deadline. Pre-entries are due Wednesday before each show to avoid a post-entry penalty of \$20.00, and there are no scratch fees. We will be running *two rings at each show* to keep the show day short.

Hollyhurst has three outdoor rings and an indoor ring. Outdoors are composed of a stone dust base with a sand cushion. They are approximately 125' x 275'; 150' x 300' and 100' x 200'. The 80' x 250' indoor ring is composed of EuroFelt footing and will be open for schooling or used as a show ring if inclement weather occurs. Additionally, there is an outdoor arena available for schooling and lunging, which is 150' x 300'.

As always, we are open for suggestions regarding our shows. Our goal is for you, the exhibitor, to have a successful, satisfactory experience.

In the event there are less than three entries in either of the Low/Pre-Children's Horse Division or the Low/Pre-Adult Hunter Division, these divisions may be combined at management's discretion.

1. Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be judged in accordance therewith.
2. All horses competing is Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.1, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA.
3. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners unless otherwise specified.
4. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management, Hollyhurst Farms, the Committee or property owners will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.
5. The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges.
6. No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those having official or requested duties to perform.
7. It is the tradition of the show that riders be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and the horses properly presented. Management may in its discretion bar any person from entering the ring if not suitable presented to appear before an audience. All riders must wear proper headgear at all times while mounted on the show grounds.
8. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decision shall be final.
9. All fees must be paid and entries completed before numbers can be issued. Membership cards and measurement cards (where applicable) must be presented.
10. Show management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show without being liable for compensation.
11. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees.
12. Prize money, Championships and other special awards will be awarded at the conclusion of the section, at the show office. Please allow one half hour for processing.
13. **DOGS MUST BE LEASHED**
14. It is a condition of entry that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.
15. Eight ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise noted.
16. In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, which restricts the disposal of medical waste, bio-hazardous medical waste containers will be provided by the entry office. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of this waste.
17. Depending on division size, classes may be moved to a different ring to expedite the show. In the event of a location change, a schooling break will be offered.

DIRECTIONS

FROM PHILADELPHIA AND PA TURNPIKE:

Turnpike to Exit 226 (old Exit 16) to Route 11 North, to 81 South, take Exit 47A (old exit 14E) onto Route 34 South. Go approximately 4 miles to second light. Turn left at light on Mill Street (Sheetz gas station on corner) Go approximately 1 mile to left onto Zion Road. Farm ½ mile on left.

FROM MARYLAND ON ROUTE 81 NORTH:

Take Exit 47A (old exit 14E) onto Route 34 South. Go approximately 4 miles to second light. Turn left at light on Mill Street (Sheetz gas station on corner) Go approximately 1 mile to left onto Zion Road. Farm ½ mile on left.

FROM MARYLAND ON ROUTE 15 NORTH:

Take York Springs exit, bear right off ramp. Follow Route 94 approximately 8 miles to Mt Holly Springs. At second light, turn right on Mill Street (Sheetz gas station on corner). Go approximately 1 mile to left onto Zion Road. Farm ½ mile on left.

FROM DILLSBURG:

Route 74 North approximately 5 miles to light at 174. Turn left on 174, go about 2.5 miles to four-way stop. Turn left at four-way stop, go 3.2 miles to Zion Road on right. Turn right onto Zion Road. Farm ½ mile on left.

Stabling available upon request. Stalls are 10x10 and 12x12 in a permanent structure with stall doors provided.

THE CENTRAL PENNSYLVANIA JUNIOR HORSE SHOW ASSOCIATION

CPJHSA members are entitled to earn points towards annual CPJHSA High Score Awards only after they have paid their dues and their horses have been registered with the CPJHSA. Membership and recording forms will be available at the show office. Points will be awarded following the current USEF "C" rated point schedule.

Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Hollyhurst Farm (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status.
